Advanced Mathematics Placement Policies

Students who are eligible for advanced math course placement and credit as indicated below:

1. A student whose math ACT subscore is 28 or above is eligible to enroll directly in MATH 1620, 1630, 1750, or 2410, depending upon their choice of major. Upon completion of MATH 1620, 1630, 1750, or 2410 with the grade of C- or better, the student will receive credit for the course, with 3 credit hours.
2. A student whose math ACT subscore is 28 or above is eligible to enroll directly in MATH 2000. Upon completion of MATH 2000 with the grade of C- or better, the student will receive credit for the course, with 5 credit hours.
3. A student who earns credit in MATH 1630, 2000, or 2410 via the AP, Cambridge International, or International Baccalaureate program will receive credit for the course, with 3 credit hours.
4. Students who transfer in a mathematics course at the level of trigonometry or higher will receive credit for MATH 1610, with 3 credit hours.
